Procurement Policy:


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Water Conservation

The main reasons for depleting groundwater are groundwater exploitation and lack of awareness about water conservation. Discussions were held on different ways of water conservation like farm bunding and stopping the dam. A small change dam was constructed with 10 pocket grains of sand in Godda village. Water is conserved in this village as a result, of this earthen dam, and the availability of water is ensured for the drinking of cattle and irrigation purposes
