





Education Programe

Education & Literacy Programme - 2024-25

"Education is the most powerful tool for change."
Driven by the belief that every individual deserves the light of knowledge, Jagsit Foundation dedicated significant efforts in 2024-25 to promoting education and literacy among children, youth, and adults in underprivileged and tribal communities of Godda, Jharkhand.

Key Initiatives Undertaken:

Non-formal education Centres in were set up in areas where access to formal schooling is limited. Children engaged in basic literacy, numeracy, and creative learning through activity-based modules.

Adult Literacy Classes were conducted for women and older individuals who had missed the opportunity to study earlier. This included reading, writing, and financial literacy training.



School Readiness Support was extended to children from marginalized families. Educational kits, school bags, uniforms, and tuition support were provided to prevent school dropouts.

Digital Literacy Drives [8] for youth and adolescent girls introduced them to basic computer skills and digital tools, essential for navigating modern opportunities.

Achievements at a Glance:

Over 700+ children benefited from learning support across rural belts.

150+ adults achieved basic literacy, many of them women from SC/ST backgrounds.

100+ youths trained in basic digital skills, preparing them for employment and further learning.



SC/ST & Minorities Development Programme - 2024-25

In line with its core vision of inclusive growth and social justice, Jagsit Foundation implemented several targeted initiatives for the upliftment of Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), and minority communities in Jharkhand during 2024–25. These communities, often marginalized due to historical inequalities, were given a platform to access basic rights, improve livelihood opportunities, and gain social awareness through a series of integrated programmes.





Key nitiatives:

Skill Development Workshops:

Tailored vocational training in trades like tailoring, mobile repairing, beauty care, and handicrafts helped youth and women earn sustainable incomes.

Health & Nutrition Camps:

Conducted medical camps with free check-ups, especially focusing on tribal belts with poor access to healthcare.

M Awareness Drives:

Legal literacy sessions, rights awareness camps, and counselling sessions were organized to inform communities about government schemes, reservation rights, and welfare programs.

Cultural Inclusion & Identity Preservation:

Efforts were made to celebrate and preserve local tribal and minority art, language, and traditions through cultural programmes and exhibitions.




1. Introduction & Background

In India, the demographic dividend represents a powerful opportunity. With over 65% of the population below the age of 35, skill development has become a national priority. However, a significant section of the youth-particularly from SC/ST, minority, and economically weaker backgrounds-faces challenges such as school dropouts, lack of access to formal training, and unemployment.

Recognizing this urgent need, Jagsit Foundation has aligned its goals with the Government of India's flagship missions like Skill India, Atmanirbhar Bharat, MSME, and PM-DAKSH. The aim is to create a bridge between unskilled labor and employable, skilled youth by offering accessible, inclusive, and industry-aligned vocational







To equip underprivileged youth, especially women, SC/ST, and minorities, with industry-relevant skills.

To promote self-employment through entrepreneurship training and micro-enterprise support.

To ensure social and economic upliftment by integrating them into the formal job sector or self-help ecosystem.

To support local and sustainable craft traditions via modern training methods.

3. Methodology and Approach

The programme was conducted in various phases across urban and rural areas of Godda. The model included:

Community Mobilization:

Field teams organized village-level awareness camps to identify interested participants from marginalized groups. Partnerships were built with local panchayats, SHGs, Anganwadis, and schools.

Skill Assessment & Counseling:

Participants were profiled through baseline surveys, and personalized counseling helped align their interests with suitable training trades.

Customized Training Curriculum:

Each course was designed in line with NSQF (National Skills Qualification Framework) and industry standards. The curriculum included theory, practicals, and soft skills...

Training Infrastructure:

Well-equipped centers were set up with necessary tools, machinery, and digital equipment. Sessions were conducted by certified trainers with practical industry experience.

Road Safety Programe



In the year 2024–25, Jagsit Foundation intensified its efforts in promoting road safety awareness as part of its commitment to community well-being and public health. With the rise in road accidents across India, our organization recognized the urgent need for targeted education and behavioural change among the public, especially youth, pedestrians, and twowheeler users.

Major Activities Conducted:

Public Awareness Campaigns

Organized rallies, poster exhibitions, and street plays (nukkad nataks) in high-traffic areas like markets and bus stands to raise awareness about safe driving practices.





Key Cobjectives

Workshops in Schools & Colleges

Conducted over 15 interactive sessions on traffic rules, helmet & seatbelt use, and the dangers of overspeeding and mobile phone usage while driving.

Driver Training & Orientation

Collaborated with local transport unions to provide training on defensive driving. emergency response, and first aid for auto-rickshaw and truck drivers.

Distribution of IEC Materials

Handed out pamphlets, reflective stickers, and helmet-use posters to over 3,000 community members and students.

Road Safety Pledge Drives

More than 5,000 participants pledged to follow road safety rules and encourage others to do the same.

Collaborations with Authorities

Partnered with the Traffic Police Department, District Transport Office, and National **Highways** Authority to co-organize awareness events during Road Safety Month

Reflecting on Challenges & Learnings in 2024–25



In the journey of social service, challenges are not roadblocks—they are powerful teachers. For Jagsit Foundation the year 2024–25 was both enriching and demanding. As we strived to deliver impactful programs in health, education, women empowerment, and environmental conservation, we encountered various obstacles that tested our resolve and adaptability.

Despite our best planning, some on-ground realities offered new insights and the need to recalibrate strategies.

Here, we present some of the core challenges we faced and the key lessons that emerged from them:

Challenge 1: Limited Access in Remote Areas

Many of our beneficiaries reside in tribal and interior rural zones where infrastructure, communication, and transport are still underdeveloped. Reaching these areas with healthcare, literacy programs, or road safety awareness posed logistical challenges.

What We Learned:

Collaborating with local volunteers, community leaders, and existing grassroots groups greatly improved our reach. Flexibility in planning and decentralizing resource mobilization helped us respond better to local needs. ation, and renewed purpose.

Challenge 2: Cultural Sensitivity in Women & Child Programs

In certain areas, deep-rooted traditional beliefs resisted women-centric empowerment programs, especially related to reproductive health or vocational training.

What We Learned:

Cultural respect is non-negotiable. Instead of pushing modern solutions, we adopted a community dialogue approach—engaging respected elders, showcasing success stories, and using relatable language. This gradually shifted mindsets more inclusively.


